Pay your pastor because...

He was sent by God to you to help you grow in Christ. (1-2)

He has the same rights and liberties you have as a believer in Christ. (3-6)

He needs to stav focused and grow in his calling. (7)

He knows that Scripture teaches this practice and Jesus Christ himself commanded it. (8-14)
