The single greatest need in our nation today is Jesus Christ living within a revived church.

What is revival? Ultimately Christ Himself seen, felt, heard, and active moving in and through His body on earth.

A true pursuit of God for revival includes:

- A grateful reflection on God's past work vv. 1-3
- An humble <u>admission</u> of our <u>present need</u> vv. 4-9
- An Godward <u>anticipation</u> of our <u>future hope</u> vv. 10-13
- A holy <u>passion</u> for God's <u>ultimate purpose</u> vv. 6 & 9
 - o "that" we would find joy and satisfaction in Him alone!
 - o "that" His glory would be preeminent in our lives and churches!
