Lasting, impactful service owns a conviction that...

Repudiates <u>isolated</u> ministry, but joyfully serves <u>Christ's church</u> together. (8-9)

Relies on intentionally investing in the Gospel of Jesus Christ. (10-11)

Requires giving your best efforts to Jesus Christ and His church. (12-13)

Rewards result from a thorough inspection of the quality of your work. (14-15)

How can knowing what He will be looking for be an encouragement to each of us?
