When you are in conflict with another believer, consider...

Not going outside the church for resolutions, because you will lose every time. (1-8)

The **HUGE** distinction between you and the unrighteous. (9-10)

How Jesus Christ treated you when you were offending Him. (11)

- Determine your selfish need to be right more important than trusting God's outcome. (7)
- Disgrace your brother or sister for whom Christ died. (8)

In what ways were the results the opposite of the above list?

In what way would the "unrighteous" of 6:9-10 be unqualified to solve a dispute between Christians?

In what way would the "washed," the "sanctified," and the "justified" be qualified to solve the same dispute?
