We need the courage to believe...

God's ultimate judgment is inescapable. (1)

God's <u>voice</u> directs us to continue forward in <u>unique</u> ways. (2-14)

God's warnings and His standards are important. (15-21)

God is able to completely save all those who call upon Him. (22-27)

Why do you think they don't heed His warnings?

Are there people you know that you would be tempted to think they are beyond hope? If so, why?
