Trusting God's direction requires...

Understanding God is not dependent on you, but He is depending on you. (1-5)

Believing God's promises, expecting God's power, and relying on God's presence. (6-9)

Taking action once you are aware of God's agenda. (10-18)

## Questions for Discussion:

God was clear to Joshua (then 80-85 years old) about what He wanted Joshua to do. Do you know what are the good works God has prepared for you to do (Eph 2:10)? If so, what do you sense it is?

How do you see God working *in* you to prepare you for what He wants to do *through* you?

Which of God's *promises* are of particular encouragement to you? Why?

Have you seen God's *power* show up as you were seeking to serve Him? What did He do?

Have you ever experienced a time when you felt *God's presence* was absent? If so, when?

Is there something you believe God wants you to take action on this week? If so, what is it?

Are there ways fear of someone or something gives you cause for hesitation? If so, what is it? (Meditate on 1:6-9 for encouragement)
