Real Life is...

Revealed in the Eternal Son of God becoming flesh. (1-2a)

Designed to be experienced and shared. (2b-3a)

Established in a personal relationship with Jesus Christ and those who know Him. (3b)

Marked by a great and abundant joy. (4)

[Sermon Summary]

How do you get real life? How do you experience life and life to the full.

The only way to have real life, and life to the fullest is to know and experience Jesus Christ. The only way to have lasting satisfaction in this life is to have an authentic relationship with Jesus, and share this with other people. If the eternal God lives in us, then evangelism is as natural as breathing. Real life is established in a <u>personal relationship</u> with Jesus Christ and those who know Him. If we know Jesus through a personal relationship then it is marked by great and abundant joy.

Discussion Starters:
