After Failure... Then What? Joshua 8

Your failure is not the end because...

God is always <u>merciful</u> when we <u>deal with</u> our sin. (1-2)

God is creative and fresh in His methods to receive glory. (3-23)

God is able to accomplish what we cannot complete on our own. (24-29)

God still desires for us to worship Him and honor His Word. (30-35)

Did you stop to intentionally give Him thanks for it? If not, set aside time this week to pause and worship Him for it.
