- Our <u>DUTY</u> to pray "Now I appeal to you, brothers,"
- Our <u>REGARD</u> for Christ –
 "... by our Lord Jesus Christ..."
- Our <u>LOVE</u> FOR the Spirit –
 "... and by the love of the Spirit"

HOW we should pray for Christian leaders-v. 30b

"sunagonidzomai" = to contend with adversaries; to fight; to strain.

WHAT we should pray for Christian Leaders - vv. 31 & 32

- Prayers for PROTECTION
- Prayers for <u>PROSPERITY</u>
- Prayers for PROVISION
