Examine your status in Christ's kingdom. (1-4)

Model Christ-likeness for other believers. (5-9)

## Treat fellow believers like you would treat Jesus Christ Himself. (10-14)

## *Questions for Discussion:*

1. What are some ways in which Christians can move from a place of dependence on God to independence from Him? Why is this a temptation for us anyway?

## Accountability question:

Are there ways you have become more independent from God the longer you have been a Christian? What will it look like for you to move back to a place of greater dependence on Him?

2. What is the difference between a *strong* Christian and a *weak* Christian (cf. Romans 14:1-15:4)? Do you or have you known Christians that have caused other *weak* Christians to stumble? If so, how?

How can we protect our Christian liberty while at the same time not causing others to stumble?

## Accountability question:

Is there someone you may have caused to stumble? What will it look like for you to try to make it right?

- 3. Pastor Jeff listed five ways we can be guilty of despising others:
  - Cluster by preference (being partial to others like us)
  - Be indifferent to, bothered by or judgmental of others
  - Ridicule differences in others
  - Take advantage of others
  - Despise those who speak truth to us

Which of these ways do you think Christians can be most guilty of? Why?
