Our current earthly bodies are simply a hint of what is to come. (35-38)

Our resurrection bodies will be far superior and uniquely suited to glorify the Lord. (39-44)

Our resurrection bodies will finally resemble the likeness of Christ. (45-49)

Questions for Discussion:

(vs 35-38)

Why is Paul so hard on those asking questions about our raised bodies?

What does the Bible say about our glorified bodies? (Ex 34:29-35, Matthew 17, Acts 6:15)

(vs 39-44)

How are humans uniquely made to bring God Glory?

How have you as an individual been designed uniquely to bring God glory?

How has this changed, or stayed the same, as you have grown in Christ?

(vs 45-49)

What is it specifically that Jesus (second Adam) has done for you personally?

What does that mean to you daily?

How does this bring you hope?

If you believe in Jesus, as your Lord and Savior, you will have an eternal body in heaven. If not, you will spend eternity in hell, and fire. What does this mean to your daily life? What is God calling you to do for those around you that do not believe in Jesus?

What can you, specifically do this week, to be used by God, and live out God's plan for your life?
