When it comes to human sexuality...

God created something more beautiful and liberating than self-gratification. (12-13)

God will empower His design and will hold you personally accountable. (14)

God designed a union that becomes wonderfully satisfying or incredibly painful. (15-17)

God delights in you when you <u>flee immorality</u> and <u>glorify</u> Him. (18-20)
